

Lining Up is On Our Schedule

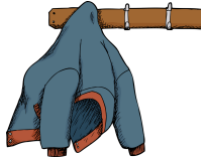
We have a schedule at my school. It helps us know what is next. Sometimes, going somewhere is next.

The teacher knows when we have to go. We do, too, because this picture on our schedule.

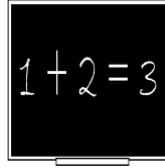
