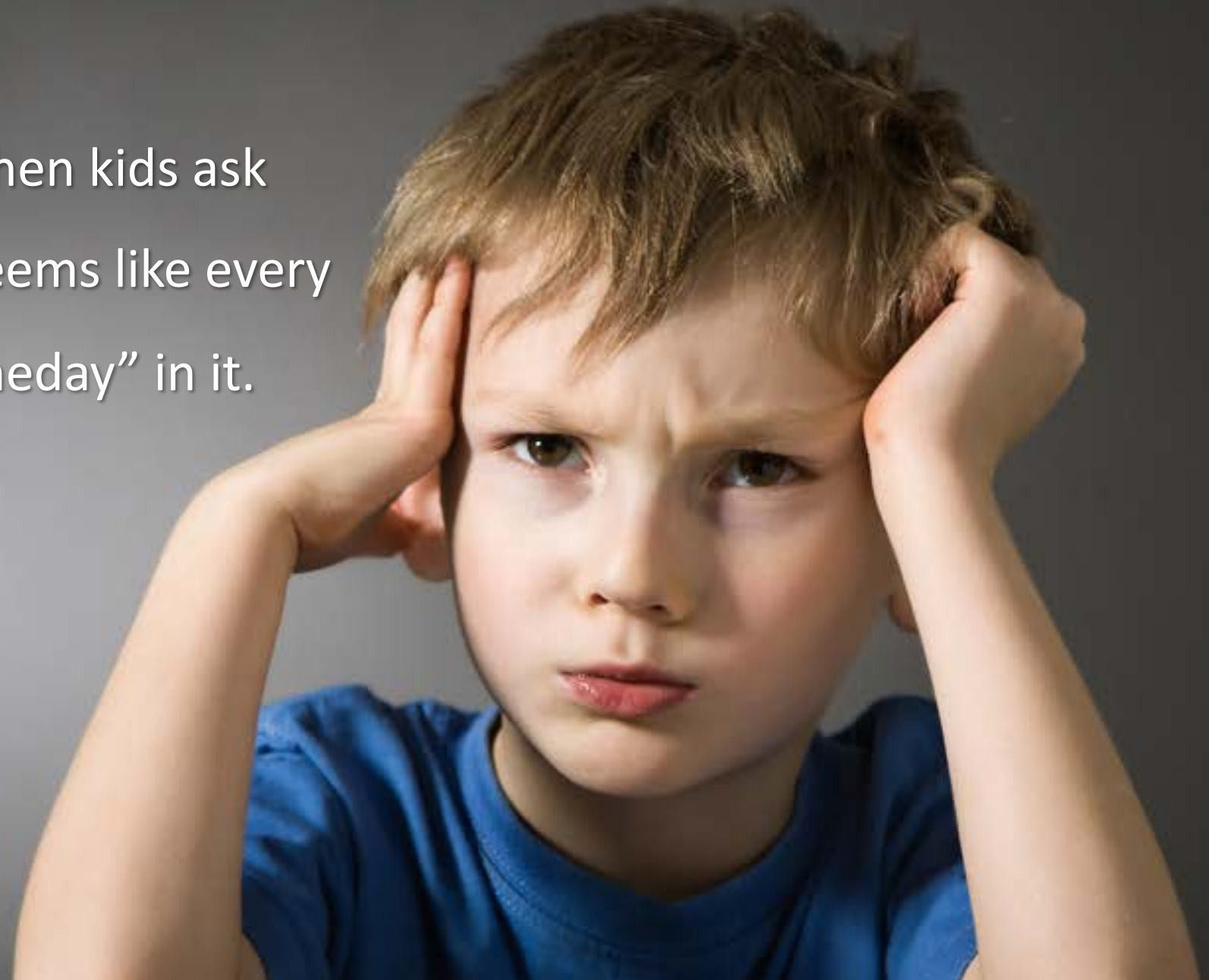

like...






“Someday.”
